BRAIN INJURY IDENTIFICATION CARD



If you are a Client of Headway Ayrshire, you will be eligible to sign up for your personal Brain Injury Identification Card. The card will provide information on your brain injury, detailing any difficulties you may have, i.e. concentration difficulties, memory difficulties, speech impairment, anxiety etc.

The card can be used in everyday life to assist with any difficulties you may be faced with, for example, in local shops, when using public transport, or when you are on a night out with friends.
