Following a Client consultation exercise last year, we have made some changes to the way the groups operate and have extended the running times to allow more Clients to attend and to offer more activities.

We have two Community Rehabilitation Groups running as detailed below:

- South Group: Tuesday's Sutherland House, Ayr.
- East Group: Thursday's Hurlford Community Centre, Hurlford.

Timetable for the Groups

10.00 am until 12.00 noon – Morning Session 12.00 noon until 1.00 pm – Break (lunch) 1.00 pm until 3.00 pm – Afternoon Session

Cost for Attendance

Attendance for morning or afternoon only - £3.00 Attendance all day - £5.00

At both Groups we have an exciting and varied programme of activities on offer.

At the South Group, there is the opportunity to take part in arts and crafts activities, a discussion group, cognitive education, literacy and numeracy, health, wellbeing and nutrition, and needlecrafts.

At the East Group we offer the chance to participate in a discussion group, Cognitive Education, health, wellbeing, and nutrition, and have recently held mindfulness sessions.

There is a small donation payable for attending the Groups. This contributes towards tea/coffee/biscuits and the cost of room hire.

If you would like to attend all day, you are welcome to bring a cold packed lunch to enjoy during the break period. Please note, we are unable to heat up or cook any food on the premises, so something like a sandwich is ideal.

Both Groups are very friendly and welcoming places and provide an excellent opportunity to meet others and access very valuable peer support – and learn a new skill or improve on some old ones!
